RESOLUTION

REMARKS

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of Smt. Teresa Silva and requested the gram sabha members to extend the cooperation to hold the gram sabha meeting.

1) V.P. Secretary read out the minutes of the previous meeting held on 26/10/26 and informed the members that the respective proposals are forwarded to the concerned departments.

W.R. Res no. (1) of Smt. Vaz the letter will also be forwarded to ~~Vaz~~ Veterinary Minister and to the local MLA.

Gram Sabha members asked sarpanch about what action have been taken on the vegetable / fruit vendors. How come these vendors are conducting their businesses without the panchayat NOC. To which Sarpanch informed the members that the panchayat have granted NOC for three vendors and when one is pending before the court and the matter is subjudice.

Sover. Carbons placed on record to initiate action on these vendors as it is a loss to the panchayat and panchayat should charge them for their businesses for the period they have runned the business without permission.

Sarpanch informed the gram sabha members that she will look into the matter and initiate action.

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1) Chair placed before the members the Master Plan at Colva Beach under Swadesh Darshan 2.0 scheme wherein officials from GTOC were present to explain the plan to the Gram Sabha members.

However, Gram Sabha members requested the Sarpanch to request TCP, GIZMA to make their presence to explain the plan along with the GTOC with detailed plan.

Sarpanch informed the gram sabha members that panchayat will request all those departments to make their presence to explain the plan in the Gram Sabha.

1) Proposal received from Domingos Silva Rlo Colva regarding robberies in the village of Colva specially in 1st ward and 2nd ward and has created fear among the people living in the area and request the panchayat to install the CCTV cameras in the jurisdiction of Colva.

To which Sarpanch informed the gram sabha members that the panchayat have already forwarded the file to BDO for approval and panchayat is awaiting for the same under 15th Jman e Jmel.

Gram Sabha member Domingos Silva also placed on records to take serious concern of the street lights at Colva Beach as they are in horrible state as it creates a negative impression on the

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stretches a few meters leading to the main road. Sarpanch informed the gram sabha members that file is pending before the BDO for the approval. The file was pending due to less budget was allocated on the gram swaraj and this file requires amount of ₹ 20 lakhs to purchase 2 cameras.

Judith Almeida proposed to use CSR from these hotels who are using the water and electricity of the villagers.

Sarpanch informed the gram sabha members that she will personally follow up the files pending before the BDO.

Judith Almeida proposed to write a letter to all hotels to utilize the CSR for the development.

4) Proposal received from Melum Dasilva R/o Chandolim regarding discussion on water and electricity in village Coloe. Melum brought to the notice of the gram sabha that the population in the village has considerably increased due to which the existing residents particularly in the areas of Chandolim and ward no. 111 are already facing serious water shortages. He further stated that the construction of swimming pools in new residential and commercial projects is one of the major causes contributing to the excessive consumption of groundwater resources.

During the discussion Smt. Judith Almeida placed



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<p>on records that water supplied from the Sabalim day may not be sufficient to cater to the continuously increasing population of more large scales projects and new residents are allowed in the village, which may ultimately deprive the existing local residents of their rightful access to basic resources. project such as Bagdem project comprising of 10 vilks have reportedly dug two borewells and are utilizing ground water resources without any permission putting additional strain on the limited water resources of the village, which could lead drying up of wells and depletion of ground water level which would affect the future generations. as the ground water level is already dropping by several wells gradually drying up. As many outsiders many into the village are accustomed to lifestyles including swimming pools. After detailed deliberation Melan Dasilva proposed that the V.P. should take a firm stand and refuse permissions for projects that place excessive burden on the village's natural resources. He also proposed that V.P. should write to the DOP & BDO informing them about the hardship and concerns faced by the villagers due to increasing pressure on water resources. Melan Dasilva also proposed that panchayat should shortlist and appoint a competent agency to conduct a study to determine the carrying capacity of our four villages under jurisdiction of V.P. Colva so as to assess the sustainability of future developments and infrastructure requirements. with regards to power supply it is also proposed that the electricity department be requested to conduct a site inspection on the jurisdiction of V.P. Colva and install transformers wherever necessary in order to ensure adequate and uninterrupted electricity supply to the residents in view of the increasing population. Sarpanch informed the gram sabha members that she will discuss this issue in the panchayat meeting and take the necessary steps / action and communicate the same to concerned authorities.</p>
